



“And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us.” (John 1.14)

For the past few months, my son has been experiencing major separation anxiety. Not only is he going through the emotional stage of separating his identity from his mother (what many call the “terrible twos”) but his mother also recently spent a week in Colorado visiting family. He (along with his three sisters) stayed in West Virginia with me. I found him repeatedly walking around the house calling for his mom.

Have you ever missed someone really badly? So badly that it hurt? You longed to be with them, but your current circumstances did not allow it? Someone you really loved, and who you

knew loved you, but time and space were simply not shining on you at the moment?

This time of year we celebrate what theologians call the Incarnation of Christ. And I am fully aware of the revelatory purpose of God becoming man, in order for us to See what He is truly like. But I want you to also consider another reason for why the God of the Universe would become one of us.

I want you to follow the common thread in each of the following verses: “Let them construct a sanctuary for Me, that I may dwell among them.” (Exodus 25.8) “They shall know that I am the LORD their God who brought them out of the land of Egypt, that I might dwell among them; I am the LORD their God.”

(Psalms 68.18) "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us." (John 1.14) "Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord." (1 Thessalonians 4.17) "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God." (Revelation 21.1-3) "Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them." (Revelation 7.15) "They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day . . . then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, 'Where are you?'" (Genesis 3.8)

Could it be that simple? Could it be that one of the reasons why He became Human was simply that He misses us? And that was the only way He could get close enough to us. That ever since the Garden He has longed to be with us. And thus, the longing in the heart of God drove Him to become a tiny Babe in Bethlehem. "Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and you will call His name, Immanuel, which is translated God with us." (Matthew 1:21)

Something to ponder this holiday season. That God simply desires to be close to us because He loves and misses us.

**Southwest SDA Church : Orangevale, CA**

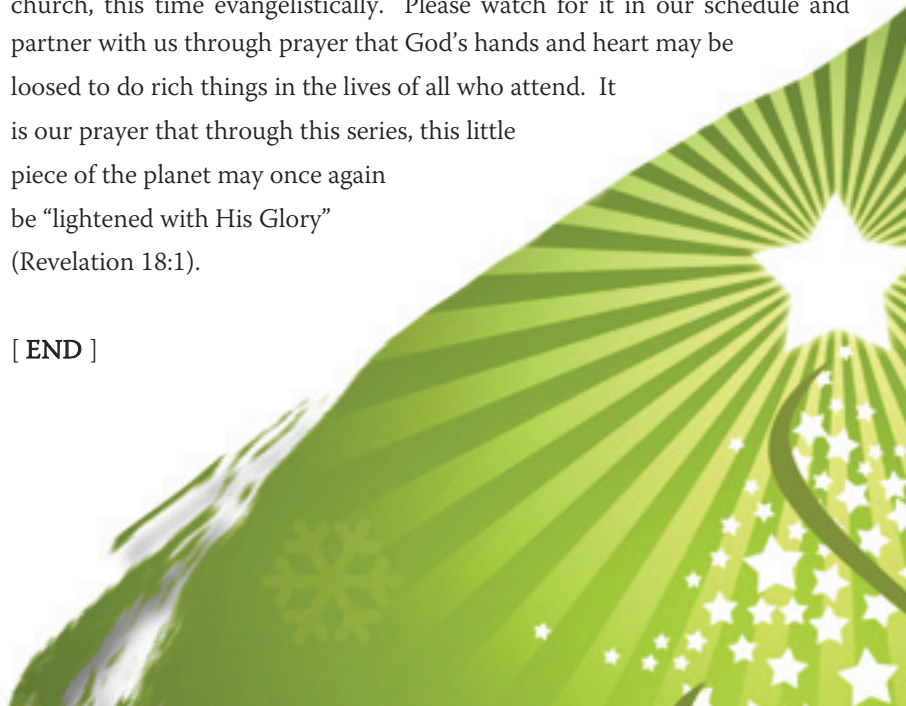
