	<u>Matthew 27.45</u> —From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land.
	Luke 23.44 – It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon.
	John 1.5–The light shone in the darkness, and the darkness did not over- come it.
	Luke 11.21,22—When a strong man, armed to the teeth, stands guard in his front yard, his property is safe and sound. But what if a stronger man comes along with superior weapons? Then he's beaten at his own game, the arsenal that gave him such confidence hauled off, and his precious possessions plundered.
	<u>Colossians 2.13-15</u> —For he has forgiven us all our sins; he has cancelled the bond which was outstanding against us with its legal demands; he has set it aside, nailing it to the cross. There he disarmed the cosmic powers and authorities and made a public spectacle of them, leading them as captives in his triumphal procession.
<u>*Luke 4.13</u> —When the devil had fin- ished every test, he departed from him until an opportune time.	<u>*Matthew 27.46</u> —About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?")
Systematic Rejection of Jesus Christ <u>Matthew 27.43</u> —He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he wants to; for he said, 'I am God's Son.'"	Psalm 88.4-5 —" I am reckoned among those who go down to the pit; I have become like a man without strength, forsaken among the dead, like the slain who lie in the grave, whom You remember no more, and they are cut off from Your hand"
