And You Too! (Handout 3)

Matthew 27.45—From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land.

Luke 23.44—It was now about noon, and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon.

John 1.5—The light shone in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it.

Luke 11.21,22—When a strong man, armed to the teeth, stands guard in his front yard, his property is safe and sound. But what if a stronger man comes along with superior weapons? Then he's beaten at his own game, the arsenal that gave him such confidence hauled off, and his precious possessions plundered.

Colossians 2.13-15—For he has forgiven us all our sins; he has cancelled the bond which was outstanding against us with its legal demands; he has set it aside, nailing it to the cross. There he disarmed the cosmic powers and authorities and made a public spectacle of them, leading them as captives in his triumphal procession.

***Luke 4.13**—When the devil had finished every test, he departed from him until an opportune time.

Systematic Rejection of Jesus Christ

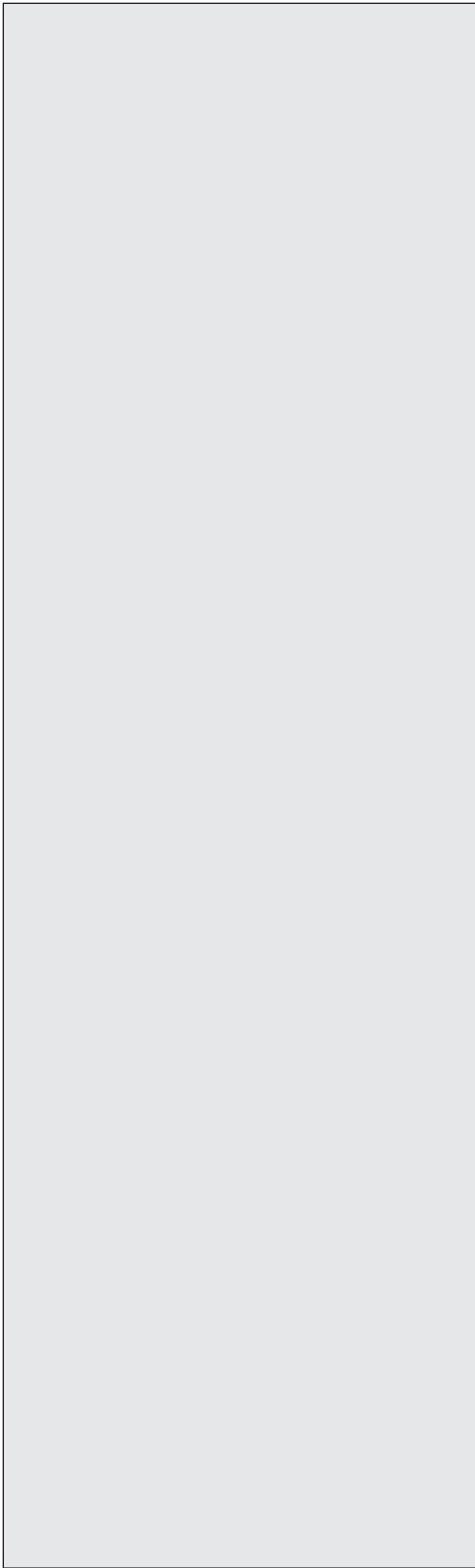
Matthew 27.43—He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he wants to; for he said, 'I am God's Son.'
