How The Death and Resurrection of Jesus Saves Us From "Death"

Psalms 2.8—I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.

Zechariah 2.11—Many nations will be joined with the LORD in that day and will become my people. I will live among you and you will know that the LORD Almighty has sent me to you.

Zechariah 8.20-22—This is what the LORD Almighty says: "Many peoples and the inhabitants of many cities will yet come, and the inhabitants of one city will go to another and say, 'Let us go at once to entreat the LORD and seek the LORD Almighty. I myself am going.' And many peoples and powerful nations will come to Jerusalem to seek the LORD Almighty and to entreat him."

Zechariah 8.23—This is what the LORD Almighty says: "In those days ten people from all languages and nations will take firm hold of one Jew by the hem of his robe and say, 'Let us go with you, because we have heard that God is with you."

Zechariah 14.9—The LORD will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one LORD, and his name the only name. <u>Romans 15.8-9</u>—For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's faithfulness, so that THE PROMISES MADE TO THE PA-TRIARCHS MIGHT BE CONFIRMED . . .

Acts 2.23-24— . . . You, [under the Satan] with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was **IMPOSSIBLE** for death to keep its hold on him.

Acts 20.25- ... I have gone about preaching THE KINGDOM will ever see me again ...

Acts 28.23–... He witnessed to them from morning till evening, explaining about THE KINGDOM...

Acts 28.30-31—For two whole years Paul stayed there in his own rented house and welcomed all who came to see him. He proclaimed THE KINGDOM of God and taught about the LORD Jesus Christ—with all boldness and without hindrance!

Luke 9.23-24—Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it.



to my brothers and tell them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: "I have seen the Lord!" And she told them that he had said these things to her. On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you! . . . As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." And with that he breathed on them . . .

<u>2Corinthians 5.17</u>—Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, **THE NEW CREATION** has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

Ephesians 2.15—His purpose was to create in himself one **NEW HUMANITY** . . .

<u>Matthew 26.64</u>—"You have said so," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: FROM NOW on you will see THE SON OF MAN sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN."

Luke 22.20—In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the **NEW COVENANT** in my blood, which is poured out for you. (cf. Exodus 24.8)

<u>2Peter 3.13</u>—But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a NEW HEAVEN and a NEW EARTH . . .

<u>Revelation 21.2</u>—I saw the Holy City, the **NEW JERUSALEM**, coming down out of heaven from God . . .

<u>Matthew 4.23</u>–Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of **THE KINGDOM**, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. (See also Luke 9.2)

John 12.20-33—Now there were some Greeks among those who went up to worship at the Festival. They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, with a request. "Sir," they said, "we would like to see Jesus." . . . Jesus replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds. Those who love their life will lose it, while those who hate their life in this world will keep it for eternal life . . . Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour?' No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name!"Now is the time for judgment on this world; now the prince of this world will be driven out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself."

<u>Hebrews 2.14</u>—Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil— and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.
