

## LETTING GOD FIND YOU

When You said, “Seek My face,” my heart said to You, “Your face, O LORD, I shall seek.” (Psalms 27:8)

Every person “moved to seek the Savior” does so only because “Christ is drawing the soul by His love” (*Christ Object Lessons*, p. 45). There has been much talk this year concerning the need for God’s people to seek Him as never before. To this I say, “Amen!”

However, I want to add a word of caution. Do not think for a moment that in so doing we are taking the initiative. As David stated above, if we are moved to seek God’s face as never before, this is evidence that our hearts are responding to God’s work because He is drawing us to seek His face as never before. God is seeking us much more than we are seeking Him, for “salvation does not come through our seeking after God but through God’s seeking after us” (*Ibid*, p. 189). Notice the principle that “the sheep that has strayed from the fold is the most helpless of all creatures. It must be sought for by the shepherd, for it cannot find its way back. So with the soul that has wandered away from God; he is as helpless as the lost sheep, and unless divine love had come to his rescue he could never find his way to God” (*Ibid*, p. 187.3).

Please, don’t misunderstand. I do not want to discourage anyone from seeking God’s face, but there is a danger in thinking that in our seeking there is some merit. God is the initiator. We are the responders. If we are calling out to God, it is only because He first is calling out to us.

As this new year begins, rather than making outlandish promises that you know you won’t keep, try surrendering instead. There are two reasons to do this. First, “your promises and resolutions are like ropes of sand. You cannot control your thoughts, your impulses, your affections. The knowledge of your broken promises and forfeited pledges weakens your confidence in your own sincerity, and causes you to feel that God cannot accept you . . .” (*Steps to Christ*, p. 47). The second reason is that it is not through mustering more spiritual energy that we experience a deeper closeness with God, but through simply not resisting. “The sinner may resist this love, may refuse to be drawn to Christ; but if he does not resist he will be drawn to Jesus; a knowledge of the plan of salvation will lead him to the foot of the cross in repentance” (*Ibid*, p. 27).

This new year, when God asks you to spend more time with Him, surrender.

When God moves you to pray, surrender.

When God moves your heart to reach out with love to some soul in need, do not resist. Surrender. For it is in these precious moments, not

that we find God, but we allow Him to find us.

“The question arises, ‘How do we submit ourselves to God?’ It is simple. Look at your life; see what things pertain solely to the present, natural life, those things that you do by nature. Take a survey of the things that you are addicted to, which you know are not Christ-like, but which cause you condemnation, even by your own heart. Now you have doubtless done this; you have also repeatedly tried to overcome them and put them away, but have not been able to do so. But you sincerely desire to be rid of them. You would rather have Christ than your own ways. Therefore you say, ‘Here, Lord, take me as I am; I give myself into Thy hands, for Thee to do with me as thou wilt; take all these evils from me by the power that rests in Thee alone. Just as I am, without one plea, But that thy blood was shed for me, And that Thou bids me to come To Thee, O Lamb of God, I come, I come.’” (E.J Waggoner, *Baptism and Its Significance*, p. 1) †

## Our Sins Purchased

Christ “gave Himself for our sins.” That is to say, He bought them, and paid the price for them. This is a simple statement of fact; the language used is commonly employed in referring to purchases. “How much did you give for it?” or, “How much do you want for it?” are frequent questions. When we hear a man say that he gave so much for a certain thing, what do we at once know? We know that that thing belongs to him, because he has bought it. So when the Holy Spirit tells us that Christ gave Himself for our sins, of what should we be equally sure? That He bought our sins and that they belong to Him, not to us. They are ours no longer, and we have no right to them. Every time we sin we are robbing the Lord, for we must remember that Christ has purchased not merely the specific acts of sin that we committed in the past, but the sins that are in us and that break forth. In this faith there is righteousness.

## He Has Bought Us, Too

This follows from the fact that He has purchased our sins to deliver us from ourselves. Our sins are a part of ourselves; nay, they are the whole of us, for our natural lives are nothing but sin. Therefore, Christ could not buy our sins without buying us also. Of this fact we have many plain statements. He “gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity.” (Titus 2:14) “Ye are not your own; for ye are bought with a price.” (1Cor.6:19) “Ye were redeemed, not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, from your vain manner of life handed down from your fathers; but with precious blood, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot, even the blood of Christ.” (1Pet.1:18,19, R.V.)

## Accepted in the Beloved

How often the Gospel worker hears some one say, “I am so sinful that I am afraid the Lord will not accept me;” and even people who have long professed to be Christians often mournfully wish that they could be sure of their acceptance with God. The Lord has given no ground for any such doubts. The question of acceptance is forever settled by what we have just read. Christ bought us, together with all our sins, and He has paid the price. That shows that He has accepted us. Why does a man go to the shop and buy an article? Because he wants it. If he has paid the price for it, having examined it to know what he was buying, does the merchant worry he will not accept it? Not at all; the merchant knows that it is his business to get the goods to the purchaser as soon as possible. If he does not deliver the goods to the purchaser, he is guilty of fraud. The buyer will not indifferently say, “Well, I have done my part, and if he doesn’t care to do his, he need not—that’s all; he may keep the things if he wants to.” No. He will visit the shop and say, “Why have you not given me what belongs to me?” He will take vigorous measures to come into possession of his property. Even so it is not a matter of indifference to Jesus whether we surrender ourselves to Him. He longs with an infinite yearning for the souls that He has purchased with His own blood. “The Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.” (Luke 19:10) God has “chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world,” and so “He hath made us accepted in the Beloved.” (Eph.1:4-6) (*The Glad Tidings*, Waggoner pp. 18-19)
